Voluntary Recognition of the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge No. 90, Sarpy County Department of Corrections

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103, the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the County and the Fraternal Order of Police ("FOP") entered into a Memorandum of Understanding via Resolution 2019-095 on April 23, 2019 ("MOU") which set forth their intent regarding the transition of county jail operations to the control of the Sarpy County Department of Corrections; and,

WHEREAS, the County agreed to voluntarily recognize a new FOP bargaining unit for Department of Corrections employees upon a showing of sufficient employee interest consistent with Rules 10 and 11 of the Nebraska Commission of Industrial Relations, as a term of the MOU; and,

WHEREAS, the FOP has provided the County with documented proof of sufficient employee interest for the formation of FOP Lodge No. 90, a copy of which is attached hereto as Appendix A and incorporated herein by this reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners, that, effective July 1, 2020, Sarpy County hereby voluntarily recognizes the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge No. 90 as the sole and exclusive bargaining representative for the following employee classifications of the Department of Corrections, excluding supervisory, part-time, seasonal or temporary employees: Corrections Officer, Corrections Sergeant, Booking Clerk and Staff Support.

The above Resolution was approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with the applicable law on the 07 day of July 2020
